PUNT, PASS, CATCH, & PULL STAFF INSTRUCTIONS Saturday October 12, 2024

Skills Challenge set-up is at 8:00 am at the Otis M. Andrews Sports Complex, 2402 E Cherry Street. Look for the white pop-up tent. All supplies will be on site. Remember to wear your Plant City Champions for Youth shirt. Competition is 8:30 to 10:30 am, awards will be announced at 11:00 am. We need the workers to stay for the awards presentation.

Below are some details regarding the skills challenge. Please review them to become familiar with the rules, scoring, etc.

- Player Score Card (shown below) once registered, every participant gets this sheet with the top half already filled in by the registration table staff. Player will hold it until his/her turn comes up and then give it to the scorer (clipboard holder) at the line-up. Scorer must enter the distances reported from the field and then give it back to the participant who takes it back to the registration table. Workers at the registration table total the distances and time, write the total in the top right corner and file it in the proper age group sequentially with the longest total distance on top.
- Rules:
 - o Punt & Pass Rules
 - Tennis shoes or cleats only (no bare feet)
 - Must use the provided equipment
 - One attempt at punt, pass, & pull.
 - Long distance to the nearest inch
 - No negative distances recorded, just zero (0)
 - Five-foot penalty for going over the line on punt or pass
 - Complete miss of the ball allows a retake of that skill
 - Ties are broken with participants completing the entire competition
 - o Catch Rules
 - Catching will involve participants attempting to catch three passes from any of the three designated spots of their choice.
 - Participants can change spots after each attempt.
 - Catch spots located at (15, 30, & 60 feet)
 - Feet conversion to yards (5, 10, 20 yards)
 - Bad throws will be a redo of throw
 - Catchable passes that are dropped results in a zero or X score for that attempt.
 - Flag Pull Rules
 - Each participant runs a timed pro-shuttle (5 yards-10 yards- 5 yards) and pulls a flag at each turn totaling two flag pulls.
 - One attempt at drill
 - Time is stopped once both flags are pulled, and participants return through the starting line.

 - Time is subtracted from final combined distances of other drills to equal final score.
- Measuring:
 - Be sure tape stays tight on the ground
 - Spotter marks the spot on the ground where the ball landed
 - String is pulled at a 90-degree angle from the tape to the landing spot
 - \circ $\;$ End of string is then swung toward the skill starting point
 - Distance is at the end of the string on the tape to the nearest inch
 - BE SURE TO USE THE INCHES/FEET SIDE OF THE TAPE AND NOT THE METRIC SIDE!
 - \circ $\;$ Loudly and clearly announce the distance to the scorer $\;$
